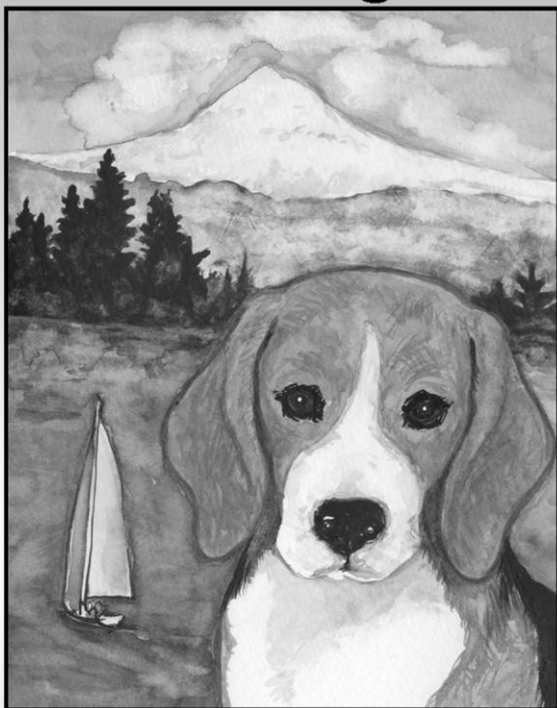

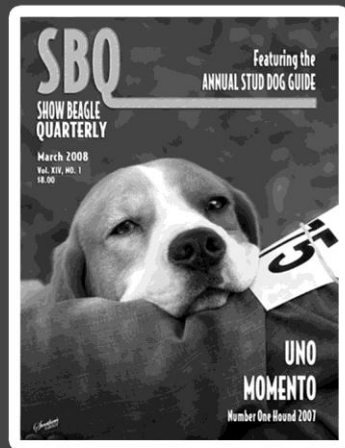

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. 2) The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog, and 3) family members must both be a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Veteran Dogs, 7 yrs & under 10 yrs
Veteran Dogs, 10 yrs & older

Veteran Bitches, 7 yrs & under 10 yrs
Veteran Bitches, 10 yrs & older

Classes are divided by variety. Veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at Specialty Shows (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 8)

BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

Dogs that are Champions of Record and/or which according to their owner's record have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of those dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for the Championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of 90-day period, the Championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until it has been confirmed by AKC.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9 & 9-12) following the judging of Best of Breed Competition.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN REGULAR CLASSES

Best Bred By Exhibitor will be selected from the Best Bred By Exhibitor Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition.

BEST VETERAN IN REGULAR CLASSES

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition.

AWARDS OF MERIT

The specialty judge may at his or her discretion award Judge's Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Variety entry, plus Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, along with the Winners of the Veterans Classes. The award will be an AKC Rosette.

Novice Junior: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another provide this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship Class at this show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER PRIZE: The club is offering a Junior Showmanship prize of Etched Glass Hurricane Lamp to the Best Junior Handler, provided there will be competition for this award, a minimum of two class winners present to compete for the award. The junior handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showman-ship Classes shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize. Each Junior Handler shall receive a gift bag for participating.

SWEEPSTAKES RULES

Puppy Sweepstakes

Classes: Each age division is divided into dogs and bitches in each variety.

6 mos. & under 9 mos.
9 mos. & under 12 mos.
12 mos. and under 18 mos.

1. Entry fee is \$18.00
2. The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age and under 18 months of age.
3. The Puppy Sweepstakes judging will take place before regular judging.
4. Dogs **MUST** be entered in a regular class.
5. There will be separate sweepstakes for each variety.
6. Entries of champions are not accepted.
7. Professional Handlers may only handle puppies of which they are registered owners.
8. **PRIZES:** All entry fees for Puppy Sweepstakes will be divided as follows:
 - 30% to be retained by Phoenix Arizona Beagle Club
 - 35% to Best 13" in Sweepstakes
 - 35% to Best 15" in Sweepstakes

Veteran Sweepstakes

Classes: Each age division is divided dogs and bitches in each variety.

7 years & under 10 years
10 years and older

1. Entry fee is \$18.00
2. The Veteran Sweepstake is open to all dogs 7 years and older.
3. The Veteran Sweepstake judging will take place before regular judging.
4. The dogs may be spayed or neutered.
5. Dogs **DO NOT** have to be entered in a regular class.
6. There will be separate sweepstakes for each variety.
7. There will be no handling restrictions.
8. **PRIZES:** All entry fees for Veteran Sweepstakes will be divided as follows:
 - 30% to be retained by Phoenix Arizona Beagle Club
 - 35% to Best 13" in Sweepstakes
 - 35% to Best 15" in Sweepstakes

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

1. A recording fee of .50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only.
2. Entries must reach show secretary, Kathy Hand, 315 S. 163rd Street, Gilbert, Az., 85296, Wednesday, May 26, 6:00 MST. Fees must accompany entries. The club and/or Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice. **No refunds of \$4.00 or less will be made.**
3. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
4. Entries not on official AKC Entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies a condition to acceptance.
5. Owners are to have their dogs ready to go into the ring promptly, so judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only to be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler. Waiting for dogs is a courtesy extended to owners and handlers. There is no American Kennel Club or club rule requiring a judge to wait for an owner or handler to Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.
6. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. **There will be a \$4.00 fee charge for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.**
7. Owners must familiarize themselves with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books may be obtained from A.K.C., 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.
8. The club, their Show Secretary or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS (CONT.)

- 9.** Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee.
- 10.** Entry fees will NOT be refunded if it is impossible to open or complete the show because of riots, civil disturbance, fires, an act of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or other acts or cause beyond the control of the club.
- 11.** Phoenix Arizona Beagle Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the Club or any official thereof.
- 12.** Foreign exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- 13.** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from the regular classes to the Best of Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.
- 14.** Junior Handlers who win a third Novice class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from Novice Class to the Open Class provided the this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
- 15.** There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
- 16.** No ex-pens under grooming or judging tents will be allowed.
- 17.** Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the classes and/or breed and the Show Secretary advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of show. None will be mailed.
- 18.** Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club, its members or agents in the event a vehicle must be entered in order to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- 19.** The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.
